Sacramento area and had no idea about Roseville. It was definitely uncharted territory for me!" Rocky shares.

"We decided to take a leap of faith with a safety net: we'd invest two years, and if it didn't work out, we'd move back to the Bay Area. It took us only a few months to be completely sold! We fell head over heels in love with Roseville so fast that we haven't looked back since.
